## Wedding Requirements for a legal Marriage in Antigua

Documents do not need to be sent to the resort in advance. The wedding couple should be traveling with their documents. Nonnationals are required to have their:

- 1. Birth certificates (both bride & groom)
- 2. Passports (both bride & groom)
- 3. If divorced, they must have the final divorce decree (both bride & groom) If documents are in a foreign language, they must be translated and notarized.

The couple must arrive two (2) business days in advance of the wedding.

The cost for the legal wedding is a total of \$410 USD, which includes the marriage license and minister.

Witnesses are required for a legal wedding. Two (2) people must witness and sign the marriage certificate. The resort can provide these witnesses should the wedding couple not have them.

The wedding couple will be given a marriage certificate on the day of the wedding. A certified copy will be required for legal transactions in your home country, which the wedding coordinator at the hotel will get from the court house. There is a fee of **\$10 USD per copy** for this, which is paid in cash to the wedding coordinator at the resort.
