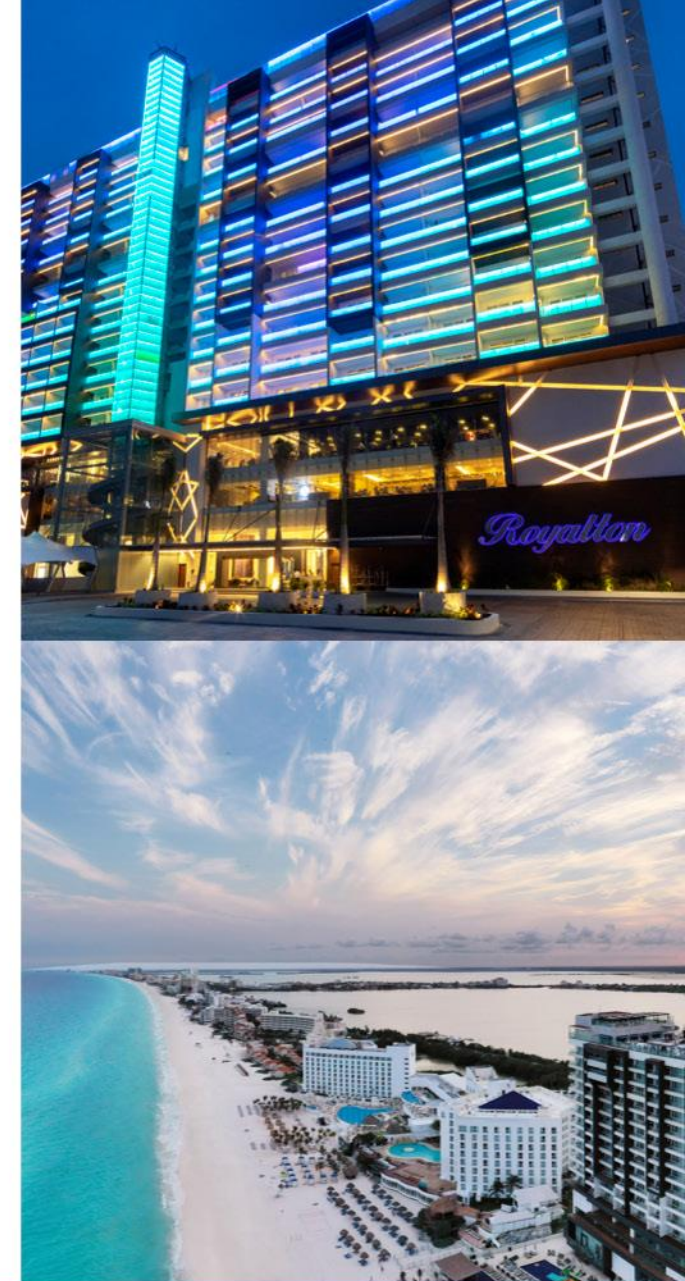


EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- Promote the involvement of stakeholders such as employees, guests, suppliers and suppliers in RLR sustainable culture, communicating the best practices implemented.

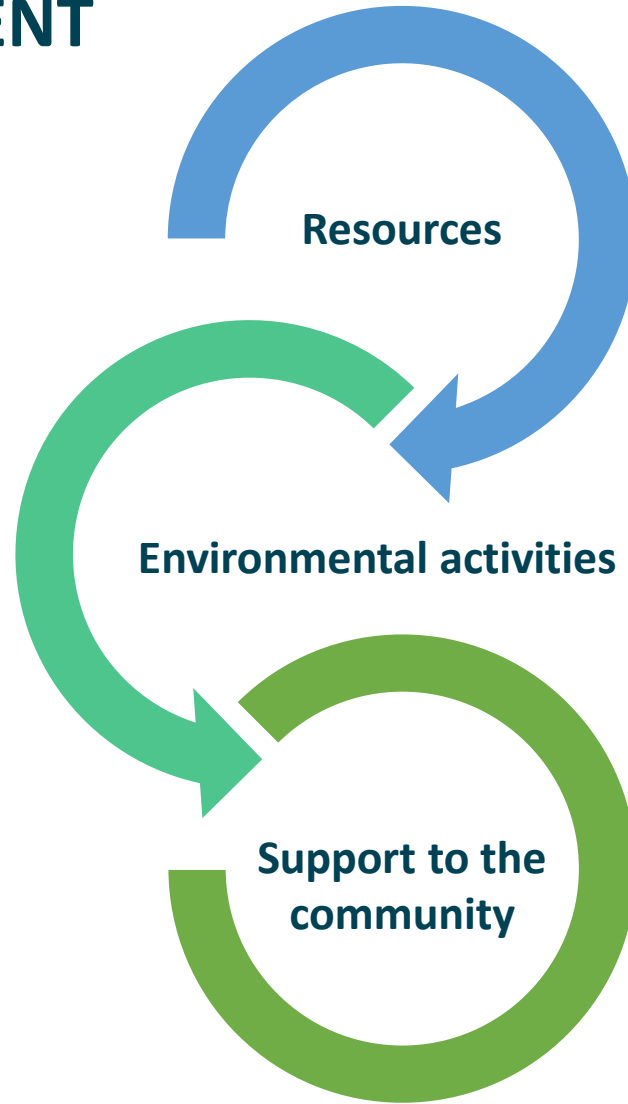

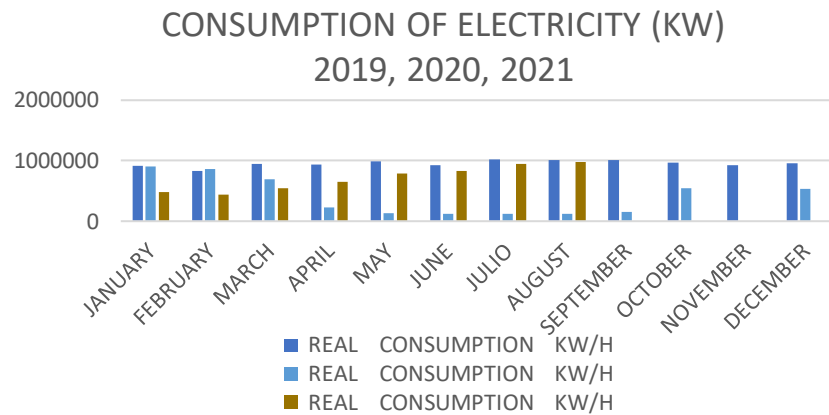

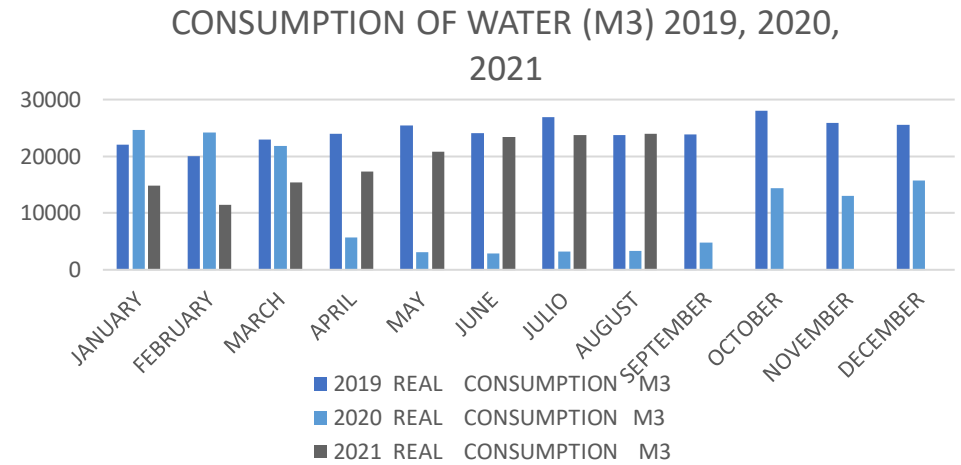

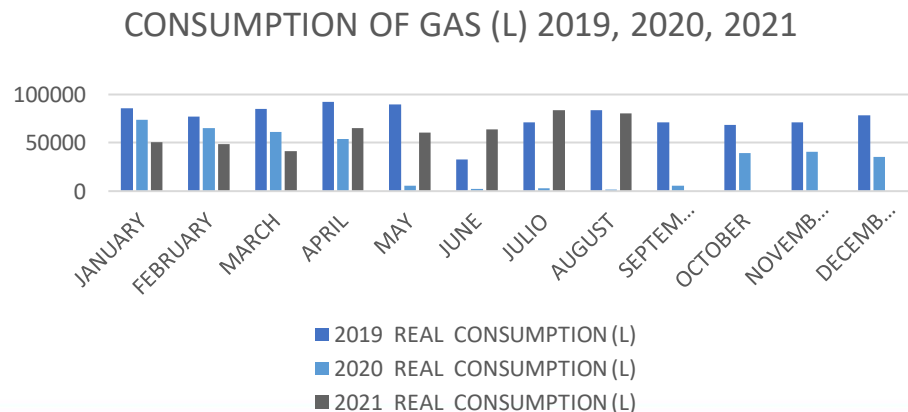
Electricity consumption comparison graph

- Generation of a sustainable culture (internal environmental campaign)

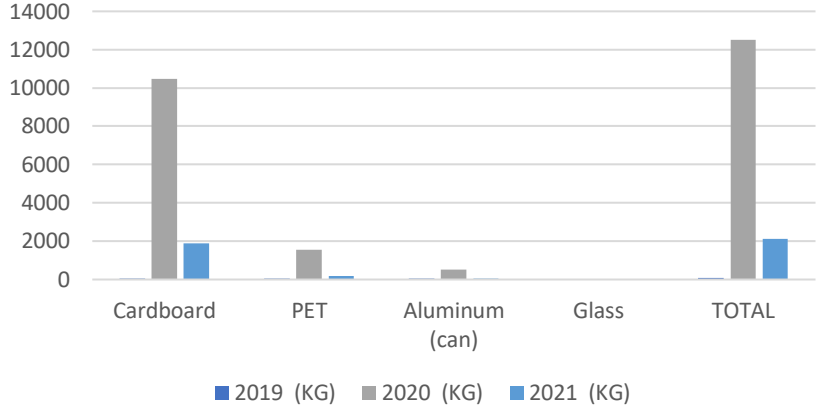
WASTE MANAGEMENT

Proper waste management has always been a central part of Royalton White Sands Montego Bay's commitment and environmental awareness.

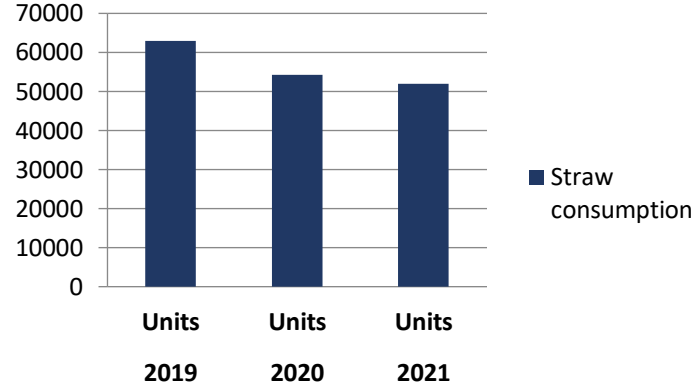
Among the awareness-raising practices are:

- Constant training to reinforce awareness on the subject

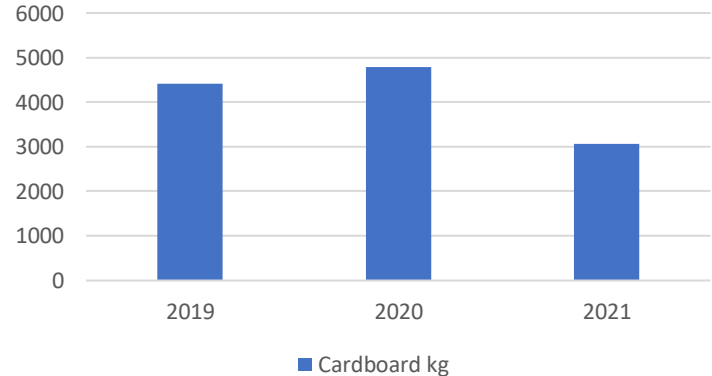
ANNUAL COMPARISON OF WASTE
